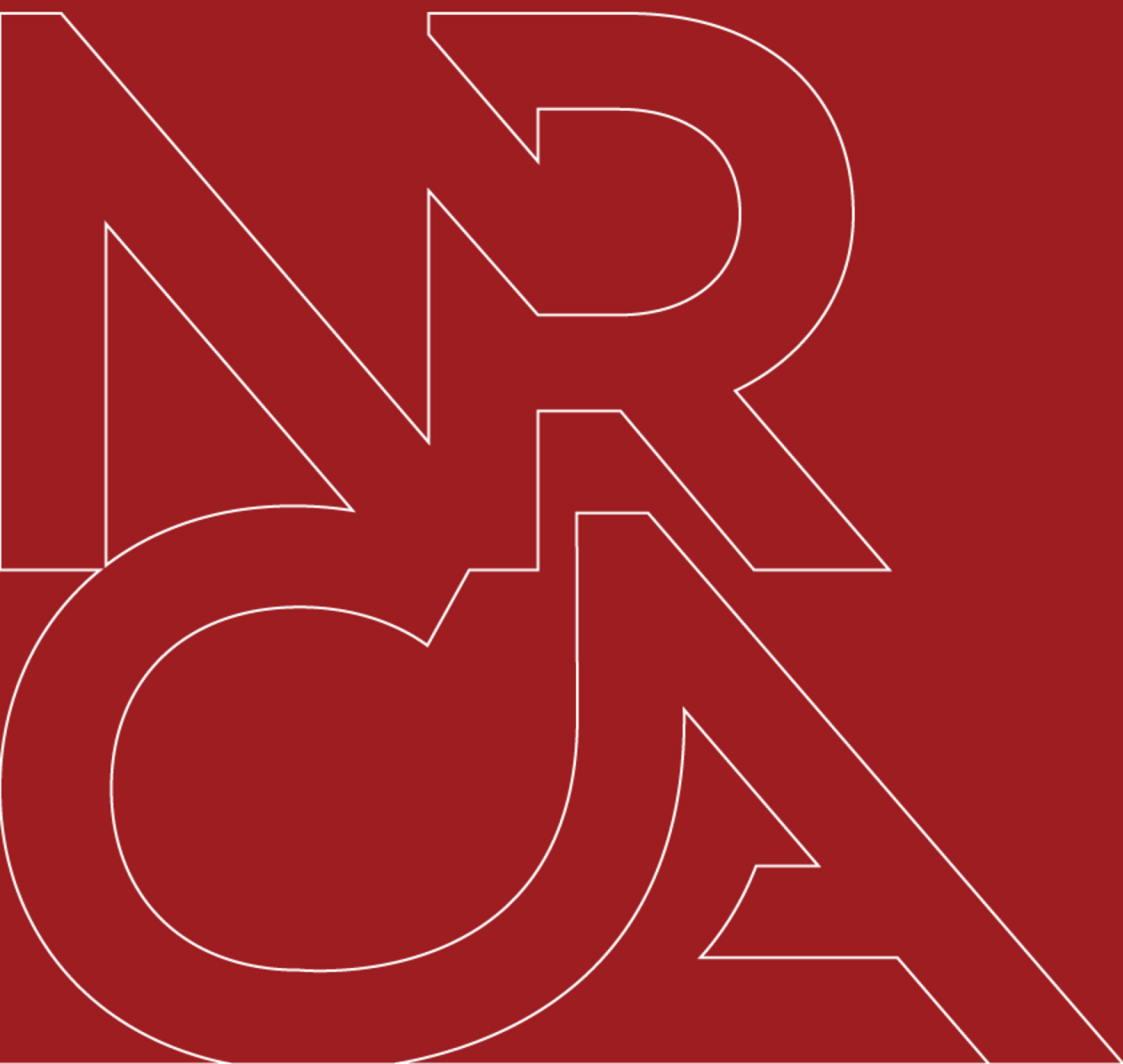

# MEMBERSHIP TYPES

Find the NRCA Membership that's right for your company! Whether you're a contractor, supplier, or support industry in additional ways, the NRCA has a membership type tailored to your role in the construction industry. Our network brings together professionals across Northern BC to build connections, grow businesses, and strengthen our region.

The NRCA represents union and non-union, general and trade contractors, manufacturers, suppliers, and other professional and ancillary organizations who service the industrial, commercial and institutional construction industry.

## INDUSTRY MEMBERS

Industry Membership is intended for companies directly engaged in the construction sector. This includes general, trade, and civil contractors; construction and project managers; as well as manufacturers and suppliers of construction-related products and materials.

Industry Members receive an membership with both the BC Construction Association (BCCA) and the Canadian Construction Association (CCA). You would be eligible to serve on the NRCA Board of Directors. Industry Members may also be nominated by the NRCA for appointment to the BCCA Board and, in turn, to the CCA Board.

## PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

This membership is designed for individuals and organizations that provide essential support services to the construction industry—such as bonding and insurance, accounting, legal, and arbitration services. Eligible members must hold professional designation through a recognized professional body (e.g., AIBC, APEG-BC, CPA, or the Law Society of BC).

Professional Services Members have full voting rights and are eligible to serve on the NRCA Board of Directors.

## ASSOCIATE

Associate Membership is for individuals and organizations that offer ancillary products or services to the construction industry, but are not directly involved in project construction and do not hold professional status through a recognized professional body. This include ancillary service providers like Information Technology, Janitorial Services, Office Supplies, Hotels and/or Non-Construction Related Equipment Supplier.

## PUBLIC OWNERS

Public Owner Membership is designed for public organizations that procure services of the construction industry, or those who set public policy or issue guidelines related to the construction industry. This includes Local Government, Crown Corporations, Health Institutions, Post-Secondary Schools.

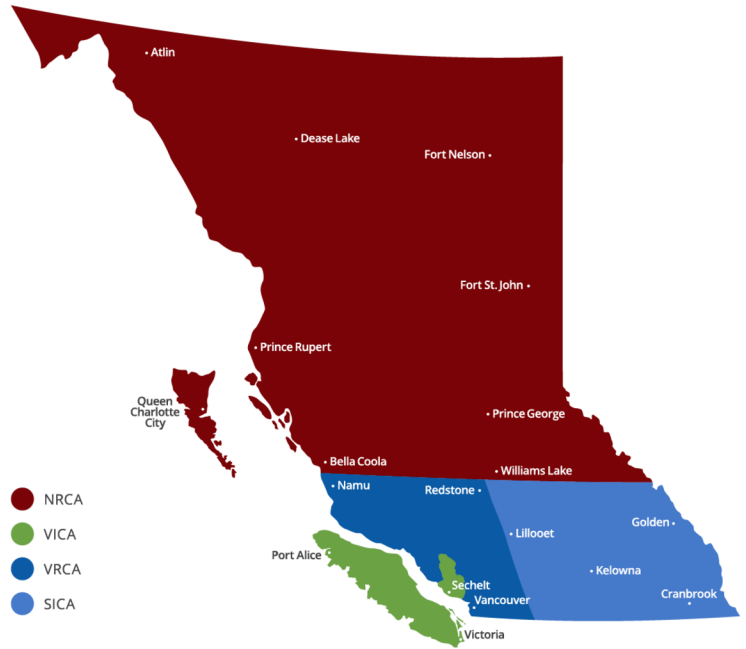
## DEVELOPERS AND PRIVATE OWNERS

Developer and Private Owner Membership is designed for individuals or organisations involved in property development or private ownership who engage with the construction industry.

# MEMBER REGIONS

Established in 1969, the Northern Regional Construction Association (NRCA) is the largest and most comprehensive regional construction association in British Columbia. Our service area spans from Williams Lake north to the Yukon border, and from the Alberta border west to Haida Gwaii—representing a diverse and vital segment of BC’s construction industry.

To better serve our members across this vast geography, membership is organized into regional categories. Please see the descriptions below to find your designated region.



## DEFINED REGIONS OF THE NRCA

### Prince George Area

Our central hub, this region includes the City of Prince George and nearby communities such as Vanderhoof. As the association’s headquarters, Prince George serves as a key connector for construction activity throughout the North.

### Peace & Northern Rockies

Covering the northeast corner of the province, this region includes Fort St. John, Dawson Creek, Chetwynd, McBride, Valemount, and surrounding communities.

### Skeena–Bulkley Valley

This area includes communities such as Terrace, Smithers, Prince Rupert, and the islands of Haida Gwaii.

### Cariboo – Quesnel

Centred around the City of Quesnel and surrounding communities.

### Cariboo – Williams Lake

This region includes the City of Williams Lake and surrounding communities.

### Out of Region

For members based outside of British Columbia or located south of the 52nd parallel. This category ensures that partners and organizations with an interest in Northern BC construction can still connect, contribute, and benefit from NRCA membership. To qualify, organizations must be actively conducting business or operating within NRCA’s regional boundaries.
